The biannual International Workshop on Coding & Cryptology (IWCC) aims to bring together many of the world's greatest minds in coding & cryptology in an informal setting. The workshop is designed as a platform for the sharing of ideas and exchange of knowledge related to advancements in coding & cryptology. There is a generally informal atmosphere encouraging interaction and collaboration.

The inaugural IWCC was held in Wuyi Mountain, Fujian Province, China, 11-15 June 2007 and attracted over 80 participants. Following this success, the 2nd IWCC will be held on June 1-5, 2009 in Zhangjiajie, Hunan Province, China.

The workshop comprises invited talks only, but all researchers and students are welcome to participate.



The setting of the workshop is in the beautiful Zhangjiajie, a city known for its unique natural scenery. It is located in the northwest of Hunan province, about 400 kilometers away from Changsha, the capital of Hunan, covering a total area of 9,563 square kilometers, with 76% mountainous area. The outstanding landscape features in Zhangjiajie are the Quartz Sandstone Peak Forest and the Karst Caves. Here you will find yourself with hundreds of monstrous peaks, beautiful waters, towering trees, deep valleys, marvelous caves and exuberant forest, forming a complete primitive ecological environment.

IWCC 2009 is co-organized by the National University of Defense Technology, China (NUDT) and the Nanyang Technological University, Singapore (NTU). IWCC 2009 is sponsored by NUDT.
